Resonance will be presented by a cast of internationally renowned musicians.

They're coming from the Netherlands, Sweden, France, the United States and across Canada to join some of Calgary's best. They range in age from 23 to 45. They've won Grammy awards, studied with the best and performed around the world – Carnegie Hall and the Lincoln Center in New York, Wigmore Hall in London, the Concertgebouw in Amsterdam, the Konzerthaus in Berlin, the

You can read about the 22 musicians performing in Resonance on our website and when you receive your 2023 festival program book, but here are some amuse bouches to whet your appetite:



Daniel Chong was the founding first violinist of the Parker Quartet, which won a GRAMMY Award for their recording of György Ligeti's string quartets. Daniel will be taking part in ChamberFest West's performance of Golijov's Last Round on July 20th, and Adams' Shaker Loops on July 22nd. You can also hear Daniel in Wijeratne's Two Poems on July 21st and the Mozart and Schumann Quintets on July 23rd.



Dutch violinist Liza Ferschtman is known for her “passionate performances and communicative qualities on stage”. You can hear Liza on July 19th in Wolf’s *With a blue dress on*; on July 20th in Respigi’s *Il tramonto* and Golijov’s *Last Round*; on July 21st in Purcell’s *The Fairy-Queen*; and July 22nd in Beethoven’s *Archduke*. Driven by the living quality and relevance of the works he presents to audiences, Oliver Herbert sees his role as a cellist as being “a conduit for magical musical messages”. Hear the magic at Studio Bell on July 21st, when Oliver performs Saariaho’s *Petals*, with Chris Sies on live electronics; on July 22nd at the Jack Singer in Adams’ *Shaker Loops*; and on July 23rd in Schumann’s *Quintet*. 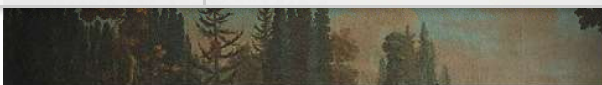
